- 3. Write a C program in which you read in a string that only contains letters of the english alphabet. Print back the string using only uppercase letters.
 - 1. Learn the relation of numbers and characters in C.
 - 2. Find out the character codes of lowercase and uppercase letters.
 - 3. Write the program, using a function to convert the letters.
